Foundation

WHAT IS THE

Foundation

The Foundation is a separate non-profit charitable entity recognized by the IRS as a qualified supporting organization of **THE LAKEWAY CHURCH**. Gifts to the Foundation are tax-deductible under the Internal Revenue Code.

HOW DOES THE FOUNDATION

Operate

The Foundation is guided by a Board of Trustees who are members of **THE LAKEWAY CHURCH**. The Foundation is controlled by **THE LAKEWAY CHURCH** and operates under clearly established guidelines as to the investment of funds and the making of grants.

GIFT

Opportunities

The Foundation receives gifts and bequests of any amount.

Many use the Foundation to remember or to honor a friend or loved one and to recognize birthdays, anniversaries or special accomplishments. These gifts are helping the Foundation to grow consistently as well as offering recognition and thanks.

Others create a lasting legacy for **THE LAKEWAY CHURCH**. For most people, there is a tremendous sense of satisfaction knowing they have managed their affairs in a way that will not only take care of their families, but will also provide long-term support for the church they care about.

TYPES OF

Gifts

When making a contribution to the Foundation, you may want to consider the following types of assets in making your gift decision.

- Cash
- Stocks
- Bonds
- A home or business
- Real estate or other property
- Certificates of deposit
- Life insurance policies
- Retirement funds
- Works of art

You can also make a gift by listing a bequest in your will or trust for a specific amount, specific property, specific asset or a percentage of your estate after you have taken care of your family.

DESIGNATING HOW YOUR GIFT IS

To Be Used

There are several funds within the Foundation's structure through which you may make contributions to satisfy a charitable objective. They include:

- ✦ The General Fund—Income from this fund allows the Foundation to respond to a wide range of the church's needs.
- ✦ The Capital Projects Fund—Supports major capital additions, improvement, maintenance and repairs to the church.
- ✦ The Benevolence Fund—Provides support for local community needs.
- ✦ The Mission Fund—Directed to missionary activities that contribute to spreading the Gospel.
- ✦ The Music Programs and Project Fund—Enhances the music programs of the church.
- ✦ The Youth Activities Fund—Contributes to the needs and activities of the youth in the church and community.
- ✦ The Memorial Garden Fund—Supports the church's Memorial Garden.
- ✦ The Scholarship Fund—Contributes to scholarships created for qualified and deserving students.
- ✦ Additional Designated Funds—Bequests or gifts of \$100,000 or more may be used to support any program selected by the donor consistent with the church's policies.
